As the Beta Lambda chapter, we focus on helping others in need. We participate in different programs with other organizations involved as well as tutoring which is specifically through Rho Chi. We also reach out to the public about different topics through many means.

Activities

The biggest activity that Temple University School of Pharmacy's Rho Chi is helping the under classmen. We do this through tutoring and participating in the school's mentorship program. Tutoring is conducted through our chapter's email address, where first year and second year pharmacy students in need contact Rho Chi about tutoring, and a Rho Chi member is assigned to tutor this student. It is up to the 2 assigned students to meet at a time/place best for the two of them. The mentorship in our school is run by both PLS and Rho Chi. At the beginning of the fall semester every first year student who wanted to participate filled out a survey about their interests in pharmacy and what they were looking to get out of the mentorship program. There was a similar surgery for the mentors involved as well. We then paired mentee to mentor based of interests and what their tentative plans for after graduation were. These were both extremely successful and worthwhile programs thats Rho Chi actively participates in. Tutoring is something that is done yearly but we have just started to participate in the mentorship program as it is new to our school.

Rho Chi as a whole has done numerous poster presentations, each of them being at different locations with different target audiences. We presented a poster about smoking cessation on Temple University's undergraduate campus. We had many temple students come up to ask about

our poster for themselves personally or for family members. We also presented a few posters at Temple University Hospital. We presented on Cough and Cold as the seasons started to change from summer to fall, and also about seasonal allergies. We also participated in Pharmacy Week at Temple Hospital where the Pharmacy Department along with school organizations, filled the entire lobby with different pharmacy related activities for patients to participate in. There was a wheel to spin, medication trivia, and also posters set up for an extremely interactive way to talk to the public. Poster presentations are something that Temple's Rho Chi participate in each year. We also conduct a student vs faculty volleyball game, held in the gym across the street from the pharmacy school. This is a great way for students and faculty to get to know each other better while having a friendly game of volleyball.

Temple University's Rho Chi also held a fundraiser this past spring semester to raise funds for activities and the induction ceremony costs. The fundraiser we had this year was White Coat clipboard. The offer the clipboard to the first second and third year students, as they come in hand for IPPE and APPE events.

Financial Budgeting

To support our chapters activities, we supplied for funding grants through the Temple Univeristy Student Faculty Center where we were allotted funds for each of our activities. If the cost of the activity costed more than what was allotted through the Student Faculty Center, the funds came from the Rho Chi Beta Lambda Chapter funds.

Installation Function

The Beta Lambda initiation function took place at the Temple University Student Faculty Center's auditorium. We inducted our new members on April 5th 2018 at 12:30pm. The new members were present along with their family members, the current chapter officers, Dr. Canney (the chapter advisor), and faculty front he school. The Temple University School of Pharmacy's Dean and assistant Dean were present and made speeches congratulating the new members on their hard work and dedication to the profession of pharmacy.

Evaluation/Reflection

I feel as though our Rho Chi activities were for the most part successful. We had a great public participation in all of our events, which made them all worthwhile. We also had great success with the mentorship program as we did an end of the year survey and theres was a 96% satisfaction rate among both mentees and mentors. Ways we can improve is increasing the number of Rho Chi members who are willing to tutor. A few Rho Chi members were tutoring 2 students at the same time and was a bit overwhelming at times. So encouraging our Rho Chi members to be more involved in tutoring can really improve that aspect of our society.
