Strategic Planning: What goals were set that relate to the Rho Chi mission?

The goal this year was to continue tutoring current pharmacy students. Tutoring services contributes to development of both the tutor and the student because the tutor enhance his/her teaching skills and the student improves academically. Rho Chi Delta Lambda Chapter members continued to offer help to student pharmacists that are experiencing difficulty with coursework through the tutoring service, which were provided by chapter members. To accommodate tutors' schedule and promote advance planning, student pharmacists needing tutoring service were encouraged to submit request in advance.

Activities

Delta Lambda Chapter continues to strive to implement the Rho Chi mission and vision to encourage and recognize excellence in intellectual achievement. The chapter had decided to continue in providing academic tutoring services to all student pharmacists for Medicinal Chemistry, Pharmaceutics, Pathophysiology, Clinical Research Methods, Positive Health Outcomes, Lifestyle Modifications, Health Care Communication and Ethics, and Pharmacotherapy. Furthermore, the chapter's goal is to increase awareness and availabilities of these services throughout the school of pharmacy so that these services are frequently utilized. In the upcoming years, the Delta Lambda Chapter will incorporate more activities to provide outreach to the academic community, including informative sessions for student pharmacists, and outside the academic community through community service.

Financial Budgeting

Before inducting new members, we collect a one-time local due. These dues are used for our yearly expenses including the induction ceremony expenses and graduation cords for graduating members. We did not have a fundraiser this year.

Installation Function

On September 28, 2017, we inducted 11 new members at the Erma Byrd Gallery on the University of Charleston campus. Inductees were presented a Rho Chi pin or key and a recognition certificate. Current chapter members, significant others, the chapter advisor, faculty members, and the dean of the school of pharmacy were in attendance.

Evaluation/Reflection

The Delta Lambda Chapter has experienced few obstacles during this academic year. As P4 officers and members are completing clinical rotations, P3 members must uphold many of the duties, including tutoring and attending meetings, to ensure the organization runs smoothly. The P3 members were truly an instrumental part of the organization this year.

This academic year the Delta Lambda chapter was not able to complete some of the previous year's activities, due to the issue stated above. In order to improve the chapter for the upcoming year, the tutoring schedule was changed in hopes of attracting more students to use the complimentary tutoring service.

Additionally, the timing of the selection of candidates, induction ceremony, and officer

instatement will be adjusted accordingly. This will allow P3 members to hold officer positions, as they are available on campus more than P4 members. I believe that this will address the issues that we faced this year and allow the organization to incorporate activities from previous years as well as implement new activities to encourage student pharmacists to achieve success throughout their time at the school of pharmacy and incorporate the mission of the Rho Chi Society.
