It was the chapter's goal to increase activity within the college and surrounding community. We also wanted to collaborate with other student organizations.

Activities

To promote cohesiveness of the chapter, a social at a local brewery in Iowa City was held in late September. In the spring semester, Rho Chi members in conjunction with the Kappa Psi fraternity chapter in the college held tutoring sessions for other pharmacy students. A pizza and trivia social was held in April for the spring semester to foster chapter involvement with the new P2 members. Other activities were unsuccessful due to limited member numbers and level of involvement with the chapter.

Financial Budgeting

Financial goals were set at the beginning of the academic year. Like with past years, funding procurement for the initiation banquet was at the forefront. In addition to the banquet, we wanted to have funds for graduation cords and any possible social activities. This year, we sold

crewneck sweatshirts in the fall and worked concession stands at the Iowa basketball games and wrestling matches.

Installation Function

This year's initiation banquet was held at the North Ridge Pavilion in Coralville, IA, on February 23, 2018. The banquet was attended by current Rho Chi members, faculty alumni members, new initiates, and their family members. The banquet started with a social hour and dinner, then a few words from our keynote speaker Dean Letendre (dean of the College of Pharmacy), followed by the initiation ceremony.

Evaluation/Reflection

This year, like with past years, the limiting factor for our chapter was member involvement. Rho Chi does not have the strongest presence at the college. This is largely due to the small number of members compared to other College of Pharmacy student organizations.
