Goals of our chapter were:

- 1) Provide academic advancement opportunities for pharmacy students
- 2) Connect the pharmacy student body and faculty
- 3) Volunteer to give back to the University of Findlay and the Findlay Community

Activities

Module tutoring/tips: This event was our first event as an honor society. It is an annual event held by our chapter. We have an open floor discussion with the pharmacy students entering their module curriculum. This event was held in the College of Sciences building and was held in the afternoon. Pizza and refreshments was provided and there was a good turnout.

Remediation tutoring sessions: When remediation exams took place throughout the semester for module sessions, Rho Chi would have tutoring sessions the night before the exam for the students taking the remediation exams. This event was held in the College of Sciences building.

Interview Aid: When new prospective students would be interviewed for a spot in the College of Pharmacy. Rho Chi members would aid the faculty member in the interview process. This took place throughout the school year many times.

After Hours Tournament: This is a school wide tournament put on by all of the honor societies at UF. Rho Chi had members attend and help with the basketball tournament portion.

Rx Day at the Ballpark: This is a brand new idea our chapter created. On a Friday night in April, we offered this event to pharmacy students and faculty. The goal was to have a night where pharmacy students of all ages and pharmacy faculty can get together and enjoy each other. It was held at 5/3 Stadium in Toledo, OH. The Toledo Mudhens baseball game was the focus of event and were provided group discounted tickets because of the amount of people that signed up. The weather was a little chilly but overall it was a great night. We hope that this event continues and becomes a tradition for the college of pharmacy.
