Activities

- 1. A presentation about Rho Chi was given during orientation week for the 1st year pharmacy students
- 2. Rho Chi Rotation Roundtable: Rho Chi members held roundtable discussion for third year pharmacy students regarding 4th year clinical rotations. It was a very successful event which included more than 20 third year students and 10 4th year students, lasting about two hours, going over many different clinical rotations and answering many questions regarding rotation selection and keys to success. This was the second year of its implementation.
- 3. Discussion of new chapter projects and implementation, including NAPLEX question bank to include practice questions and calculation problems. Also working on other chapter projects to increase member's success in professional development, NAPLEX study preparation, and other activities to increase member engagement and participation in on-campus activities.

Financial Budgeting

Rho Chi has a set budget of \$1,640 each year. The funding was obtained by submitting our budget proposal to the College of Pharmacy Dean. The budget went towards the initiation luncheon and for honor cords for the graduates.

The elections were held and the four new officers were elected.

Evaluation/Reflection

Our officers and chapter had a strong desire to continue the previous idea of increasing the size of our chapter's membership and involvement by continuing an earlier initiation for our chapter. It has continued to greatly increase our chapter membership as well as opportunities for increasing our presence on campus. This year, our chapter hosted the second annual "Rho-tation Roundtable", an event we implemented in 2017 that entailed 4th year students discussing clinical rotations with the other classes at the college of pharmacy. The event was well received with a great turnout as well as insightful information for our peers. We plan to continue the Rho Chi Speaker Series. We are continuing to brainstorm new ideas for student success including a NAPLEX question bank to help members prepare and succeed in passing our profession's

licensing exam. We also started to investigate alternate sources for funding to increase the number of activities we can host as a chapter. We hope to continue these activities and possibly add new activities to increase our presence within the College of Pharmacy. The Gamma Beta chapter is committed to continue developing all aspects of pharmacy to create the best environment both on and off campus.
