Sara Grossman, PharmD, is a Drug Information Specialist at the International Drug Information Center at LIU Pharmacy (Arnold & Marie Schwartz College of Pharmacy and Health Sciences) where she also serves as an adjust assistant professor of pharmacy practice. Dr. Grossman received her PharmD degree from LIU Pharmacy in 2007.

In her role at the College, Dr. Grossman has established partnerships with healthcare organizations and other user groups for the provision of drug information services to both healthcare professionals and consumers. She facilitated the development, funding, and launch of the first post-PharmD fellowship at LIU Pharmacy, the focus of which is on drug information and medical communications. Since that time, Dr. Grossman has been responsible for bringing additional post-PharmD fellowship programs to fruition at LIU Pharmacy.

Dr. Grossman serves as a lecturer in a drug information and literature evaluation course and precepts students completing an advanced pharmacy practice experience in drug information. She also serves as a lecturer for the School of Health Professions at LIU Brooklyn and has served as an international guest lecturer at the Ben-Gurion University of the Negev – Faculty of Health Sciences.

Dr. Grossman was selected for membership in Rho Chi as a pharmacy student in 2005 and served as the Chapter's historian the following academic year. She has served as an advisor to the Beta Theta Chapter since Fall 2014 and has been instrumental in increasing the impact of the Beta Theta Chapter on all PharmD students at the College.
